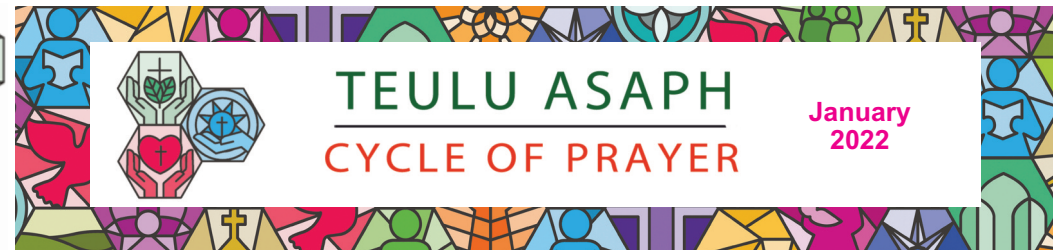

Dyffryn Clwyd Mission Area is the community of 13 churches in and around Ruthin covering the Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty in the Clwydian Range, the medieval town of Ruthin and out to the beautiful forests of Clocaenog.

The Elwy M.A serves the City and Diocese of St Asaph. The Parish Church and the Cathedral compliment each other in mission and ministry offering a diversity of worship, outreach and welcome in Christ name. Description of MA.

The present Estuary and Mountain Mission Area is based by the Dee Estuary and is a medium sized parish which consists of the Gorsedd group of churches (6), the Halkyn group of churches (3), the Flint group of churches (2), and the Holywell group of churches (3). The Mission Area was constituted in October 2014 and during the last six years we have been concentrating on having workable structures and systems in place to support the mission and ministry of the Mission Area. We are working on a number of initiatives to reach out into our communities, both as individual churches, and collectively for the larger projects as a Mission Area. One of our intentions is to employ two stipendiary lay-people to scope the opportunities for youth and children's work in the area.
